

For programs taught in Chinese:

Students must have adequate listening, speaking, reading, and writing Chinese language skills. Documents or proofs of Chinese proficiency*

Note1 : exemption : Applicants who are native speakers of the Chinese language or graduated from a school where Chinese is the language of instruction or the major in college used to be Chinese **(must attach a certificate/proof).**

Note2 : Proofs of Chinese proficiency means any related documents which issued by institutes for Chinese proficiency test such as Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) from Taiwan, Subject Test in Chinese with Listening (SAT) from United States, or certificates from Chinese courses of universities/colleges in Taiwan and so on.

Note3 : **For those applying for degree programs taught in Chinese, a photocopy of a TOCFL transcript or certificate for Level 2 or above. (Registration System: <https://reg.sc-top.org.tw/register.php>)**

- Should the applicants meet the minimum language proficiency requirements, but fall short of the department’s or graduate institute’s requirements, the department or graduate institute committee reserves the right to reject admission, grant admission offer, or grant a conditional admission offer.
- If an international student accepts a Chinese conditional admission offer, he or she will have to obtain a Chinese proficiency certificate at the designated level or above in order to be accepted for enrollment. and will be cancelled if he or she fails to provide such documents.

For programs taught in English:

Non-native English speakers must have adequate listening, speaking, reading, and writing English language skills. Please attach an English Proficiency Certificate*

Note1 : Exemption : Applicants who are native speakers of the English language or graduated from a school where English is the language of instruction (certificate/proof required).

Note2 : **Applicants must submit a transcript or certificate showing an internationally recognized English proficiency test score equivalent to CEFR B1 or above.**
